



# Samuel's Quill

## Multimedia show and self-guided tour Centre d'interprétation de Place-Royale

### RÉSERVATION REQUIRED

Duration of activity: 1 hour 15 minutes including welcome

The Centre d'interprétation de Place-Royale is located at the heart of Place Royale Square, behind the bust of Louis XIV, from which it derives its name.

Young visitors will especially enjoy the multimedia show *Place-Royale, There and Back Again*, which is 17 minutes long and features two teenagers who discover the site's treasures when they meet five characters who marked its history.

Students will then use the visitors' booklet, "Samuel's Quill", to visit three exhibitions that showcase the main themes concerning Place-Royale.

Lastly, they will explore the discovery space, *Place-Royale in 1800*, where they will learn about the daily life of a cooper's family.

#### ITINERARY AND INSTRUCTIONS

The itinerary of your visit will be determined by the multimedia show, which begins on the hour and the half hour and can accommodate a maximum of 60 people.

Please arrive at the Centre d'interprétation de Place-Royale at the hour indicated in your letter of confirmation, that is, 15 minutes before the show begins. This time will be used to welcome you to the Centre d'interprétation de Place-Royale, for you to pay admission and use the checkroom and washroom.

Should you arrive late, you might not be able to see the multimedia show.

Groups with **60 students or less** will follow the following itinerary: first, students will watch the multimedia show. Then they will be given the visitors' booklet with which they can visit the exhibitions. When they have finished, they will go and explore the discovery space in the time they have left.

Groups with **over 60 students** will be divided in two. Please tell your students and divide the group into two before arriving. While the first half of the group is watching the multimedia show, the second half will visit the exhibitions. The second half will then watch the following screening of the multimedia show, having been told in advance what time it will begin. Each half of the group will explore the discovery space in the time they have left after visiting the exhibitions.
