

Guidelines for Visitors

9 simple rules to make your visit more pleasant

The Museum team wishes you an enjoyable museum experience.

- 1 You may take photos without a flash in exhibition rooms UNLESS otherwise indicated. Watch for the pictograms at the entrance to exhibition rooms or beside objects that cannot be photographed.
- 2 Use of tripods, lighting, and selfie sticks for photography is forbidden.
- 3 Do not touch objects in the exhibition rooms.
- 4 Do not lean on glass, climb on furniture, or run inside.
- 5 Do not eat or drink in exhibition rooms.
- 6 Do not smoke or vape inside the buildings, in the interior courtyards, or on the roof.
- 7 Animals are forbidden, with the exception of service dogs.
- 8 Visitors are requested to leave backpacks, briefcases, and umbrellas in the cloakroom.
- 9 Out of courtesy, visitors are requested to leave their cellphones on vibration mode inside.
