GROUPS OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

- Free (admission and cloakroom)
- For all groups composed of people living with a physical or intellectual disability and their support persons, without discrimination based on disability or origin.

INDIVIDUAL

- Free (admission and cloakroom)
- For a person living with a physical or intellectual disability and their support person, without discrimination based on disability or origin.

Is your organization accredited to quality for free admission?

- Fill out the online form to register non-accredited organizations.
- An accredited organization is an organization whose objective is to help clientele with social impairments.

Is it possible to organize adapted educational mediation activities with guides? (Guided visits, school workshops)
